The experiences provided in the Early Years help children to love learning. Staff work with children to develop experiences that foster critical thinking, problem-solving, creativity and teamwork in open-ended play. Supported by staff, children can satisfy or extend their curiosity, use

their imagination, and experience the satisfaction and excitement of personal success and progress.

Learning takes place in a variety of contexts; in light-filled classrooms as well as in outdoor spaces that are targeted to their learning needs, including the natural bushland space on our own school site. We encourage children to develop respect for the environment by spending time immersed in nature.

Through a combination of explicit teaching and play based learning, the children in Kindergarten and Pre-Primary engage with the Western Australian curriculum, building a firm foundation for future learning.
